Tagadi Driving venue is located around 22 km south from Tallinn.

OFFICIAL MEALS

At the venue the **Show Cafeteria** is open from 13th till 15th of September at the expense of the Athletes. The opening hours are from 08:00 during the competitions and the closing depend on the clients but is expected to be at 20:00.

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ENTRY TO THE STABLES

Entrance to the international stables is allowed to the driver, the partner, the groom and to the horse owners

SHOW OFFICE

The Main Show Office is in the Main Building but during the competition it is next to the dressage arena.

Friday 13th 08.30 - 1 hour after the competition

Saturday 14th 09:00 - 1 hour after the competition

Sunday 15th 07.00 - 1.5 hour after the competition

ARRIVAL AND ACCOMMODATION OF HORSES

Horses are accommodated at the price in the schedule from Thursday to Monday
Stables are open from 06:00 till 22.00, on Thursday 09:00 till 22:00.

Stabling includes initial bedding (shavings). Additional hay and shavings are free.

For stabling questions upon arrival and/or before arrival please call Key Kunman, ph. +372 512 9686.

The electricity requests need also to be done with the FEI or the national entries.

For questions about electricity, parking upon arrival etc. at the venue contact Key Kunman, ph. +372 512 9686

PLEASE NOTE:

- All manure must be dropped in the designated area at the stables.
- It is forbidden to smoke in the stables or bring alcoholic beverages to the stable area.
- It is forbidden to park the electric vehicles on stable area or next to the flammable materials
- All dogs must be kept on a leash!

If violations are stated by the stable manager or other officials, the OC can demand a fine up to € 100 per offence.

HORSE INSPECTION

The first horse inspection is held on Thursday 12th of September 17:00 – 18:00 dressage next to the dressage arena.
All horses taking part in the CAI3* and CAI2* must be presented during the first horse inspection.

Competing horses must always wear their bridle numbers outside the stable, the bridle numbers will be published by Show Office.

Do not forget to measure Your horse's temperature twice every day and put this info into FEI Horse App

BANDAGE AND TACK CONTROL DURING FEI EVENTS

The control of boots, bandages or tack material for possible welfare issues, the presence of foreign bodies and/or application of irritating or prohibited substances may be carried out by Stewards during a class or an exercise/schooling period.

DECLARATION OF STARTERS

Please make your entries immediately after the first horse inspection in the Show Office.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Awards ceremonies for the CAI and the CAN will be held on Saturday appr. 19:00 for the dressage and for the marathon at the Indoor arena. For the cones and the combined appr. 15min. after the cones competition.
